

Finances.

Parish Treasurer John Brewer presents the previous month's results from the Operating Fund (OF), and every quarter, the status of the Endowment Fund (Art Richardson, Treasurer). The Parish Treasurer ensures that pledge and open donations plus rentals and other income are deposited and that the bills such as salaries, benefits, utilities and supplies are paid. John reports to the Finance Committee and then to the Vestry each month on the health of our finances.

2025 Year-to-Date (YTD) Operating Income and Expenses



The Endowment Fund pays for improvement and repairs to the buildings and grounds; the EF interest and dividends are transferred to the OF if and when needed to meet daily expenses. The primary EF expenses through June, 2025, have been transfers to the Operating Account, the 2025 portion of rectory repairs, the 32 new Columbarium niches, and tree trimming.

Recent Action Highlights.

Capital Improvements: Warden Marie Fox is leading the Vestry in identifying and prioritizing maintenance investments. Suggestions so far have included (not in priority order) Lea Hall painting and reflooring, church windows restoration, and parking lot resurfacing. Fundraising for the improvements will be undertaken in the spring, 2026.

Rentals: A committee led by Mother Ann, the Wardens, Victoria Reed and John Brewer, created new Rental Contract Forms. The new rates are comparable to other venues, with discounts and even full waivers for parish members. Please feel free to forward the information to acquaintances who may be looking for a venue for banquets, theater, reunions, teaching and other meetings.
